Lenoir County Landfill

**LCID Pay--\$19.00 per Ton
Minimum \$1.00**

**(Naturally Grown Material ONLY)
Trees, Limbs, Grass clippings, Weeds, Leaves, etc...
LCID = Land Clearing and Inert Debris**

**C&D Pay--\$34.00 per Ton
Minimum \$1.00**

**(Building Materials Only)
Shingles, Lumber, Wood, Insulation, etc...
C & D = Construction and Demolition Debris**

**MSW Pay--\$39.00 per Ton
Minimum \$1.00**

**(Mixed Materials)
Paper, Household trash, Furniture, clothing etc...
MSW = Municipal Solid Waste**

**ASBESTOS--\$60.00
Minimum \$60.00**

**(Asbestos Product Only)
Shingles, Siding, Insulation containing Asbestos**

***** Will only accept Asbestos from Lenoir County--Must have Asbestos Manifest*****

White Goods/Metals/Tires--Will be No Charge-- (MUST BE SEPARATED-ONLY)

*****CB & MSW Mixed--\$102.00 per ton**

Loads mixed with 25% or more of any combined material and/or cardboard.

*****CARDBOARD MUST BE BROKEN DOWN AND TAKEN
TO THE RECYCLING SITES**

*****Material from outside Lenoir County- Rates will double*****

***User Fee**--The residents of the unincorporated areas of Lenoir County are charged a \$60.00 Landfill user fee on their annual tax bills. This User Fee allows these county residents the use of the 9 recycling sites located in and about Lenoir County. These recycling sites are equipped to handle the recyclable-glass, metals, cardboard, plastics, paper, car batteries, and used motor oil. These sites are where unincorporated county residents are to take their household trash* (trash collected in the kitchen and bathroom). County residents that pay the user fee are allowed disposal of one ton (2000lbs) of waste in the Lenoir County Landfill at no extra charge (ex. limbs, shingles, construction materials etc...); once resident has reached their ton they will be charged for any additional waste disposed in the landfill at set rates.

***Garbage Pick-up**—The County residents that have garbage pick-up, city residents, and businesses are not charged the Landfill User Fee on their annual tax bills; therefore, these residents will be charged for any items brought into the Landfill -- Excluding White goods/metals, tire, car batteries, and used motor oil which are recycled items.
